High school diploma or GED, and one year of college or vocational school education in law enforcement or a closely related field. Three years of experience in law enforcement, court security or related experience in the military.

KNOWLEDGE SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of and ability to operate sophisticated computer operated security system for card key access, operate and monitor CCTV, and operate X-ray, metal detection, and fire safety equipment. Knowledge of facility subsystems and ability to detect failures and hazardous situations. Ability to use a firearm, incapacitate and handcuff safely and responsibly. Ability to dependably perform assignments without close supervision. Ability to communicate effectively and courteously with court visitors and court personnel. Ability to work harmoniously in a group setting. Ability to stand and walk for extended periods of time.

Must have a valid State of Florida Driver's License and an active Florida Law Enforcement Certification. No conviction of a felony or misdemeanor involving perjury or false statement. No dishonorable discharge from the Armed Forces of the United States.
